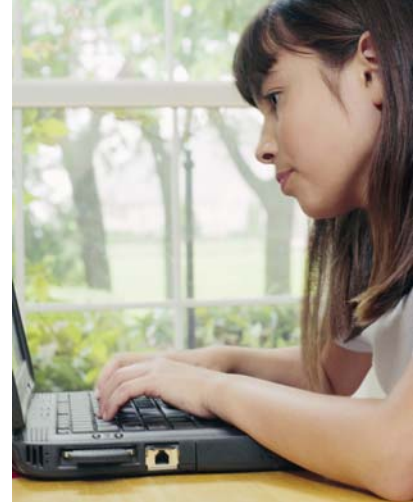


Cyber Bullying Quiz
